I will present the best example of character and behavior at all times.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game and practice.

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will support coaches and officials in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will never criticize the referee openly or directly during games. Before you attempt to interpret the Laws of the Game, be sure you know and understand them.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I will not coach the players from the sidelines. I will let the Coaches do the Coaching.

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

Focus on fun and participation rather than winning or losing.

Making mistakes is part of the learning process—don't criticize.
