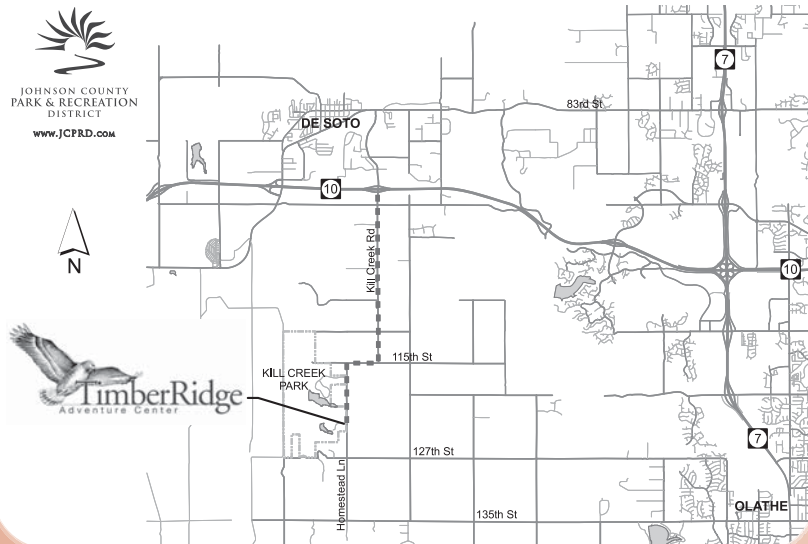
Directions to TimberRidge Adventure Center

Directions from K-10 Highway

- Take Kill Creek Road exit located approximately 6 miles west of K-7 Highway.
- Go approximately 3 miles south on Kill Creek Road to 115th Street.
- Turn Right and go 1/2 mile west to Homestead Lane.
- Go approximately 1 mile south to TimberRidge.
- Entrance is on the right approximately 3/4 miles south of the Kill Creek Park main entrance.

Directions from 135th Street/Prairie Center Road

- Take 135th Street/Prairie Center Road to Homestead Lane (located 7 miles west of K-7)
- Go 1 1/2 miles north on Homestead Lane to TimberRidge.
- Entrance is on the left at approximately 123rd St.

TimberRidge Adventure Center: *TimberRidge is a refreshing, unique, getaway regardless of the type of event. TimberRidge is the ideal setting for parties, family reunions, birthdays, rehearsal dinners, small wedding receptions, bridal showers, scouting activities or any other event you can dream up. The site is available for use by the public through reservation or program registration only, thus insuring your privacy during an event. Call to customize your rental package; items are priced separately to easily tailor a package to your specific needs.*

Welcome Center:

The Welcome Center can accommodate up to 80 people for meetings. It features a beautiful wrap-around wood deck overlooking a pond with café style deck furniture. The facility is air conditioned and also includes the use of a full size kitchen and restrooms.



Whispering Pine Outdoor Shelter:

Our new shelter, completed in the Spring of 2006, features a limestone fireplace, attached restrooms, and another view of Catfish lake.

The shelter is an ideal location for a corporate picnic or other outdoor events. Charcoal grill and seating for 200 provided with rental.



Rental Amenities

(With a facility rental the below activities are available free of charge.)

Fishing: At TimberRidge it's more accurate to call it "catching" since that is what you will be doing. Come see why this is one of the most popular activities for our summer campers. We have a variety of catfish, large mouth bass, and sunfish available for your fishing pleasure. There is also an accessible fishing dock on site. *(Catch and release fishing only. Participants 16 and older must have a state license, not sold on site. District permits are not required at this site.)*

Hiking: Enjoy the many different trails available to hike. Explore the many wonders of the TimberRidge Adventure Center as you discover Possum Holler, the Timber Trail, and the Lower Timber Trail.

Additional Amenities

(Available for an additional cost and must be scheduled in advance with a rental.)



Archery: Let one of our staff assist your group with their archery skills. Participants will learn how to hold the bow, aim, and shoot. Amount of shooting time will vary with the size of the group.



Boating: Enjoy our beautiful Catfish pond from a canoe or pedal boat. Staff will assist your group at the boat dock.

BB Guns: Try your target skills at the BB gun range. Groups will be lead through a brief safety and information session, before practicing their skill.

Climbing Tower: Experience the thrill of our Hawks Nest Climbing Tower. Participants can climb the 40 ft climbing tower. *(Health Statement and Waiver form must be completed to climb. Those under 18 must have a parent or guardian signature.)*
