Shawnee Mission Park: Water temp: 90 Water clarity: murky

Trout: Poor.

Crappie/Panfish: Poor. Anglers may have luck in early mornings. Water is very warm.

Catfish: Fair. Worms/cutbaits having best results early morning. Bites are slow in the evenings.

Bass/Wipers: Fair. Early mornings/evenings with crankbaits and plastics along face of dam.

Heritage Park: Water temp: 92 Water clarity: murky

Catfish: Fair. Few being caught with worms and cutbaits from shoreline.

Crappie/Panfish: Fair. Plastics and worms from shore or docks.

Bass: Fair. Few being caught from shore with live bait or crankbaits.

Kill Creek Park: Water temp: 90 Water clarity: murky

Trout: Poor.

Crappie/Panfish: Fair. Crappie with jigs/live bait in deeper water along tree lines.

Bass: Good. Top waters and crank baits from dam in early morning/evening.

Catfish: Fair/Moderate. Liver off shore lines.

Lexington Lake Park: Water temp: 90 Water clarity: murky

Catfish: Fair. Cutbait/liver

Crappie/Panfish: Good. Crappie on crappie jigs and minnows. Bluegills from shore with corn or worms.

Bass: Good. Crank baits or live bait from shore line.
