Catfish: Fair/Good. Livers during cooler parts of day.

Bass/Wipers: Fair. Plastics or worms.

Heritage Park: Water temp: 78 Water clarity: murky

Catfish: Fair/Good. Liver or other cut bait during mornings.

Crappie/Panfish: Poor/Fair. Jigs or worms for best results.

Bass: Fair. Plastics or worms.

Kill Creek Park: Water temp: 79 Water clarity: murky

Trout: Poor.

Crappie/Panfish: Poor/Fair. Jigging from the banks in the morning or evenings.

Bass: Fair. Plastics or worms from shore.

Catfish: Fair. Liver or other cut bait in the mornings.

Lexington Lake Park: Water temp: 78 Water clarity: murky

Catfish: Fair/Good. Liver or other cut bait during mornings.

Crappie/Panfish: Poor/Fair. Jigs in the evenings.

Bass: Fair. Plastics or worms during the morning.
