Shawnee Mission Park: Water temp: 70 Water clarity: murky

Trout: Poor. Water is very warm for trout to be active.

Crappie/Panfish: Moderate/Good. Fish are biting regularly in morning and evenings. Try live bait or small plastics for best results.

Catfish: Good. Fish continue to be active, and live bait is having the best results.

Bass/Wipers: Good. Fish are still active, and plastics of a light color will have best results.

Heritage Park: Water temp: 69 Water clarity: murky

Catfish: Fair. Fish are biting on live bait in early evenings mostly. Bites also occurring in the early morning hours.

Crappie/Panfish: Moderate/Good. Fish are active, and biting. Light colored small grubs have had best results.

Bass: Good. Fish have been active for a couple weeks, and will continue to be for the next few weeks. Top water or live bait will have best results.

Kill Creek Park: Water temp: 71 Water clarity: murky

Trout: Poor. Water is very warm for trout to be active.

Crappie/Panfish: Good. Fish have been active for a few weeks now. This will continue to occur. Best chances are during the late afternoon/early evening.

Bass: Good. Fish are continuing to be active. Best chance is with top water, or any light colored plastics.

Catfish: Moderate. Fish are continuing to be active during the early mornings and evenings. Live baits will continue to be your best chance at bites.
