

Great American Family Campout Inclement Weather Procedures

In the event of rainshowers, the event will be held.

In the event of thunderstorms and/or lightning, participants will be notified by two long horn tones and asked to move to their cars for shelter. The all-clear will be sounded by several short tones. JCPRD Staff will be in constant communication with our meteorology service, *Weather or Not*, to receive updates on the weather. If, between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m., it is projected that thunderstorms and/or lightning will be in the area for a period of longer than two hours, the event may be cancelled. Participants will be directed out of the park, but may leave their tents and other camping equipment in the park until the following day. The decision to cancel will be made on site, and no refunds will be issued.

In the event of a tornado warning, participants will be notified by a continuous horn tone and directed to The Theatre in the Park restroom facilities for shelter. The all-clear will be sounded by several short tones.

If The Theatre in the Park production is rained out participants will need to hang on to their passes and use them on another date. The passes will be reactivated and are good for any remaining show of the season.
