

Big Bull Creek Campsite

33900 West 213th Street, Edgerton, KS 66021



Amenities: There are three (3) camping pods at this location with two fire pit grills per pod. Please make sure you are at the correct camping pod listed on your reservation. Maximum Occupancy per site = 25.

- **Large shelter:** common space for all groups reserving camping space with 11 picnic tables. Please be considerate of other groups who will be camping in the other pods. There is not a drinking fountain on site however there is a water spigot at the shelter.
- **Large fire ring:** available for use by permit holders for campgrounds. Firewood may not always be available, please be prepared to bring your own. You may not cut firewood on site.
- **All seasons restroom:** will be unlocked during your reservation. It is a two-person unit.
- **Trash:** must be placed in the barrels provided. Barrels must not be moved. One (1) trash barrel will be provided with one (1) liner at each pod. If you feel you will need more than that please bring liners with you.
- **Parking lot.** Maximum number of vehicles = 25. Shared by all campground sites.
Personal vehicles allowed in parking lot ONLY. Vehicles prohibited at pods, on grass, sidewalks and asphalt walkways. Be prepared to hike in and haul camping items to pods.
- **Water:** there is a water spigot located at the shelter.

Activities:

- **Fishing:** The nearest pond is located just past 207th & Spooncreek. It requires parking on the road and hiking back to the pond. There is fishing available at ponds located on Big Bull Creek property on 199th street, also requires hiking to various ponds.
- **Hiking:** There are seven miles of hiking and bike trails stretching from the campgrounds through Big Bull Creek Park property. Please note these are shared trails.
