


Sensory Map

What to Expect ...in KidScape



This board has lights on it. It is located in the far left corner as you enter KidScape.

What to Expect ...in the Exhibit



This is a Plinko-style game where you will hear plastic pieces bounce through pegs until they land at the bottom.



This is a puzzle. You may hear people put the plastic pieces back in the pocket on the side of the table.



This is an Operation-style interactive where you will hear explosion sounds if you touch the side as you slide the joystick. It also has a red or green light at the start as well as a voice that gives you instructions.



There is a doorbell at the front of the All-Electric House. It is a working doorbell and will make a sound when pressed.



This interactive has a touch screen where you can see correspondence Reverend Meneilly received. You can use the receiver to hear excerpts of a sermon. The volume is adjustable.



There is a tv at the back of the All-Electric House garage which shows neighborhoods being built in Johnson County and how the house was moved to its current location. There is no sound.



This is a black and white television located just outside of the All-Electric House garage. It has clips from 1950's tv shows and commercials. There is sound.



This is a bean bag toss game. It makes sounds as the beanbags pass through the holes. Sounds include a dog barking, glass breaking, and ta da.



This is a typing interactive. There is a screen at the top of the typewriter. It does not make any sounds.



This is at the end of the exhibit. The TVs on the right scroll through places in Johnson County. There is no sound.

On the left, there is a green screen where you can take a photo with your group. There will be a flash of light from the camera.



This is at the end of the exhibit. You can type a memory of Johnson County on the blue screens on the right.
