Inclement Weather Procedure

Severe weather- including extreme heat, lightning, thunderstorms, tornado, and horizontal rain with strong winds- warrants changes in camp activities and location. In the event of **severe weather** campers will be relocated to indoor facilities.

In case of severe weather, the camp will move to the closest inclement weather site after placing a door notice at the Camp Shelter indicating our whereabouts. Drop off (by 9:00am) and Pick Up (by 4:00pm) will be conducted from Shelter 12. After the drop off time, and before the pick-up time, you will need to drop off or pick up from the inclement weather site, and sign your child(ren) in or out. The children will remain inside until weather allows for activities to continue outside, and children can safely return to Shelter 12. In the instance, severe weather occurs at pick up time (after 4pm), you will need to sign your child out from the assigned Inclement Weather site. A door notice posted at the Shelter will direct you to the Inclement Weather site for the day.

You may find out about schedule changes for ODC by calling Ernie Miller Nature Center at 826-2800, 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. If weather looks questionable, please send a raincoat, poncho and/or sweatshirt.
